Why can't I enter?

Are you registered? To enter, first you have to register. If you have already registered and you still can't enter, then check that you've entered your username and password correctly. This is usually the problem; if you still have trouble entering, contact the administrator of the mag.

Why do I have to register?

You may not need to do so, but registering enables you to post material and comments. It takes only a few minutes to register, and so we recommend you to do it.

I've forgotten my password!

Don't worry! You can't retrieve your password, but you can reset it. To do this, go to the login page and click on Lost your password?, follow the instructions and you'll be back online in no time.

How can I change my personal settings?

If you are registered, all your settings are stored in the database. To change them click on the Profile link (you can find it in the left-hand column of the dashboard). The Profile section contains all your settings, and you can personalise these through the profile.

How can I publish my material?

It's extremely simple. Once you have logged in, click on Posts on the left, and then on Add new.

Once you're certain that you want to publish your contents, click on Submit for review at top right. This automatically submits your contents in proof form, and the administrator or moderator will decide whether to publish. For this reason, you should check material carefully for mistakes before submitting!

Is there a remuneration?

Polimoda/Mag is something between a magazine and a blog on the world of fashion, open to anyone who wants to express an opinion or offer a new viewpoint. Consequently, both collaboration and publication of contents are completely free.

How can I change or cancel a message?

As long as the article is awaiting review, you can still change it. By clicking Edit you can view the list of your contents, and if you move the cursor of the mouse over the title the following options will appear: edit (make changes to the entire article), quick edit (change only title, date, category and little else) or trash (cancel).

What contents can I publish?

Articles, thoughts, interviews, news, events ... everything there is to say about the world of fashion and trends!

In what language should I write?

Polimoda/Mag has an international public, and so you can post your contents in English, Italian, French, Spanish ... even better in dual language.

Can I post pictures or videos?

Of course! When you're on the Add new page, in the centre you'll find the Upload/Insert button followed by four icons: the first for posting images, the second for videos, the third for songs and the fourth for other contents.

All you have to do is upload the material from your computer or from a link and then click on Insert into Post.

NB: for the images we recommend a size of 350 px.

How can I add a comment?

Simply click on Continue, which you will find at the bottom of the argument you want to comment on. A new page will open with the whole article, and then at the bottom you can write a comment and then click on Submit comment to make it public.

How do you use the post tags?

Assigning tags to the posts is incredibly simple. You can add the tags to the right of the editor, separated by a space. When you submit the proof, the tags that you have inserted are automatically associated with the post and added to the tag-list.

We advise you to choose tags made up of a single word: in this way your post can be read in association with many tags rather than just one.

What are the Administrators?

The Administrators are the users that have the highest degree of control within the mag; they can control any element, including user bans and permits, the creation of moderators etc. In addition, they may decide about the publication of the material submitted.

What are the Moderators?

The Moderators are people who are assigned a level of control second only to that of the Administrators. They can control many functions of the mag, including permits, blocking of users and other typical functions of the administrator. In addition, they may decide about the publication of the material submitted.

Who should I contact if I find a message containing a file with illegal content?

You must contact the administrator of the forum or the moderator, indicating the message and the reason why the file is illegitimate.
